You have been identified as a local landowner in Deerfield Township of at least 20 acres. We are reaching out to you for the expansion of the already existing "Southern Mecosta Whitetail Management Association," (SMWMA).

SMWMA is a growing group of landowners who have "voluntarily" banded together for the purpose of the quality management of our local whitetail deer population. The goal is to have a more balanced and healthier deer herd and ultimately bigger, more mature bucks. The SMWMA is currently going into its 5th year of existence with roughly 7,500 acres of landowners already in participation. The current members are either newly committed property owners or property owners who have already been practicing Quality Deer Management (QDM) principles for some time.

SMWMA has primarily been based out of [redacted] Township with hopes of growing its base westerly into [redacted] Township, hence the letter. Then continue to seek out additional areas to grow in years to come. Our goal this year is to secure an additional 7,500 acres, doubling our current base to 15,000 acres.

To do this, **WE NEED YOUR HELP**. Committing to this process over a period of just **ONE** year makes a **HUGE** difference in the quality of our deer herd and ultimately antler size and growth in the years to come. With some discipline, we can make a **BIG** difference in our annual deer harvest and create pride in the properties that produce them. 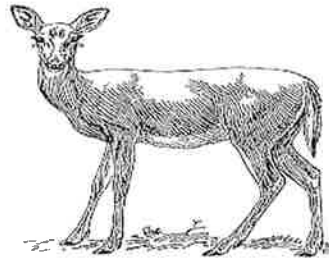
Enclosed is a questionnaire for you to fill out and return in the self-addressed, stamped envelope provided. Your response by September 1st would be greatly appreciated.
