

PROPOSED BYLAW AMENDMENT #1

Title: EXCLUDE AT-LARGE APPOINTED EXECUTIVE BOARD MEMBERS FROM TERM LIMITS.

Proposed: October 5, 2022 Executive Board Meeting

Purpose: Currently Executive Board officers are restricted to a 6 year limit of continuous service. Appointed directors are not elected and therefore, serve at the appointment of the President who is term limited. Additionally, the makeup of the executive board may be strategic by appointing someone in certain areas of need, for example, someone with a law background that is or would be a valuable resource for MUCC.

ARTICLE III CORPORATE OFFICERS

SECTION 4 – TERMS

E. ~~Appointed and~~ Elected At-Large Directors shall hold office for a term of two (2) years. There shall be a 6 year limit for continuous service.

F: Appointed At-Large directors shall hold office for a term of two (2) years. There shall be no limit on the number of terms which may be served.

G: Members appointed to fill a vacancy are excluded from term limits for the duration of the existing term.

H. The Region Directors shall be elected for two (2) year terms. There shall be a six (6) year limit for continuous service. Regions assigned odd numbers shall elect the Region Director at the Annual Convention occurring in odd-numbered years; regions assigned even numbers shall elect Region Directors at the Annual Convention occurring in even-numbered years.

I. The Treasurer shall be elected for two (2) year terms and there shall be no limit on the number of terms which may be served.
