

## PROPOSED BYLAW AMENDMENT #2

**Title:** EXCLUDE APPOINTED CONSERVATION POLICY BOARD MEMBERS FROM TERM LIMITS TO FILL A VACANCY.

**Proposed:** October 5, 2022 Executive Board Meeting

**Purpose:** Currently the conservation policy board is restricted to a 6 year limit of continuous service. After convention any openings are filled by appointment by the Vice-President and subject to executive board approval. This will only apply until the term being filled expires.

### ARTICLE V CONSERVATION POLICY BOARD

#### SECTION 6 – TERMS

A. Elected and Appointed Voting Members

1. Elected Voting Members of the Conservation Policy Board will be elected for two (2) year terms. There shall be a six (6) year limit for consecutive service. The regions assigned odd numbers shall elect their Voting Members at the Annual Convention occurring in odd-numbered years and the regions assigned even numbers shall elect their Voting Members at the Annual Convention occurring in even-numbered years.
2. Appointed Voting Members of the Conservation Policy Board will serve concurrent with the term of the Chair ~~appointing them~~ **regional election cycle of odd number regions on odd number years and even number regions on even number years.**
3. **Members appointed to fill a vacancy are excluded from term limits for the duration of the existing term.**
3. ~~For the purposes of the 2020 Annual Convention, Conservation Policy Board Voting Members elected in the odd-numbered regions shall serve a one (1) year term. This partial term will not count towards the six (6) continuous service term limit.~~
