

PROPOSED BYLAW AMENDMENT #3

Title: Regional Director Duties, Regional Meetings

Proposed: October 5, 2022 Executive Board Meeting

Purpose: After nearly 6 years with our new bylaws, it is evident that some of our members are losing touch with the leadership and activities of the organization. Making an effort to hold meetings with clubs from all over the region and inform them just how important they are to the organization as a whole is what is missing. When the new bylaws were conceived, it only made sense that "Each elected Region Director of the Executive Board shall be encouraged to convene not less than one (1) meeting a year" At the time, the ad hoc committee felt that this nudge would be sufficient. Observations since and the feedback experienced within regions shows that it is time for this bylaws amendment.

Article III

Section 3-Duties

C. Region Directors

1. It shall be the duty of the Region Director to assist the President in the performance of his or her duties in their respective region when called upon to do so by the President or the Executive Board. ~~Each elected Region Director of the Executive Board shall be encouraged to convene not less than one (1) meeting a year.~~ **Each elected Region Director of the Executive Board shall be required to attend or convene not less than two (2) club or region meetings in a year. A regional meeting can run in concurrence with a regularly scheduled host club meeting. Meetings should be in significantly different locations within the region, between conventions and the regional director shall report back to the Executive Board at subsequent Executive Board meetings.**
