Title: Bear treestands at legal bait sites prior to Sept 1

1. **WHEREAS:** Currently, it is unlawful to place tree stands on public land prior to September
2. 1st, and;
3. **WHEREAS:** Baiting for bear is lawful beginning 31 days prior to the start of bear season,
4. and;
5. **WHEREAS:** Being obligated to wait until September 1st, or over two weeks after baiting
6. has begun to place one's tree stand on public land would cause undo intrusion, and
7. potentially pattern changing activity into one's bait site, NOW;
8. **THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:** MUCC work with the proper parties to give bear hunters
9. the ability to place their tree stand on public land at actively tended legal bait sites, and
10. ONLY at actively tended legal bait sites, beginning the day baiting becomes legal.
